



FIG. 3 - TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD VOLTAGE, (V)




FIG. 4 - TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE




FIG. 5 - TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS
